## DAY GAME DRIVE SAFARI

### Day Tour From Stellenbosch

These are offered with or without transport to the reserve - self drive guests are informed to depart Stellenbosch approximately the same time as the tour provided with transport, for these are the set times for game drives and meals served daily.

Departs Stellenbosch at 06h00: Pick-up from Life & Leisure and transfer to Game Park.

08h00: Welcome drink on arrival served in the reception area.

Between 08h00 and 09h00: Full course buffet breakfast served in the restaurant at the Game Park.

09.00am: Depart on a 2 to 3 hour safari (in 4X4 safari vehicle with ranger guide) - Visit San Rock Art site.

12h30: Buffet lunch served in the African boma restaurant

After lunch guests are able to relax at the pool and are welcome to browse our African curio shop.

Approximately at 16h30: Return to Stellenbosch.

## WILDPARK PACKAGE

This park offers a day picnic area situated in an idyllic setting amongst trees with lawns and water features. There are 4 chlorinated blue swimming pools including 2 'kiddies' pools and one natural water pool.

350 shaded braai spots and 3 ablution blocks with change-rooms are provided. The picnic area is well protected from the wind and two large lapas provide shelter on rainy days. There is also a children's playground and a roller skating rink built on a dam. (Please bring your own roller skates, roller blades or scooters along.)

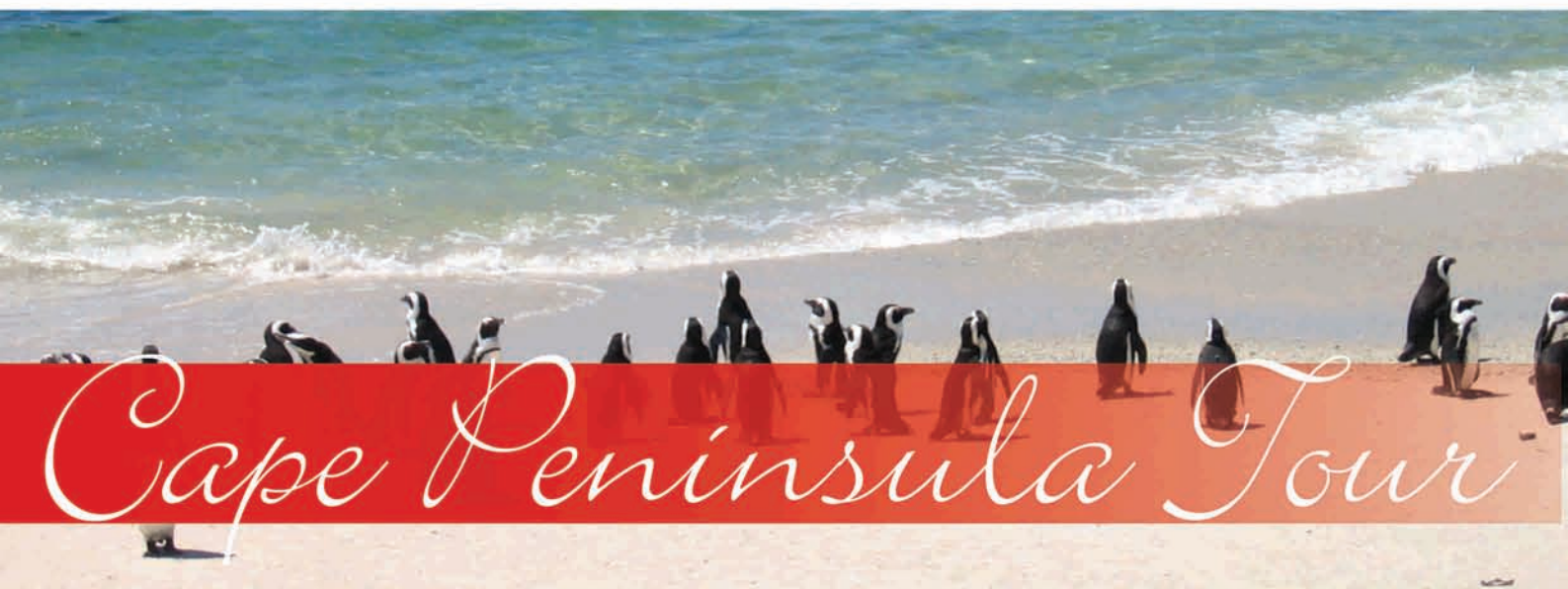
In the peak season we offer boat cruises on the lake. The coffee shop and kiosk provides tea, coffee, cake, ice cream, chips, cool drinks and sweets. Fire-wood is also available.

We are open daily from 08h00 to 18h00 except on Mondays unless the Monday falls on a public holiday.

Entrance is from R28 per person 12 years and older and from R20 per person under 12.

Booking is not required for cars. Busses are allowed by prior appointment only.

The full day wine tour departs daily and includes Stellenbosch, Paarl and Franschhoek, taking in 4 different producers for a wide variety of wines to compare. The tour begins with a cellar tour where your registered tour guide will show you how the wine is made and give a few tips on how to taste it.

The second farm opens your taste buds and the joy of the winelands begins to soak in.

A glass of wine or a beer with lunch at our excellent lunch stop restaurant is included in the price. The afternoon is spent taking in a couple more farms' vintages and imbibing the splendid scenery.

A goats milk cheese tasting is included while tasting wine with a view to write home about.

The tour departs daily (including Sundays) at 10h30am and returns at around 17h15pm.
